

# Legal Aid and Services at Vivekananda Law College

A concise Report of the Legal Aid and Legal Services Cell at Vivekananda Law College

### **Introduction:**

The importance of the Legal Aid and Awareness campaigns is a mechanism for social progress and is something that has been repeatedly stressed upon by the Government of India.

In the backdrop of poverty, Inequality, social injustice and ignorance legal aid is an effective way towards attainment of "social, economic and political" justice that is enshrined in Part III and IV of the Indian Constitution.

Imparting Legal Awareness is the first step towards ensuring prompt and effective access to justice. Keeping this in mind, the Bar Council of India mandated all law colleges and universities in India to establish and run legal aid centers or clinics. The idea was to fulfill certain standards of legal education, but more importantly, it was also aimed at engaging the students in serving their community by promoting legal awareness through these legal aid clinics and programs.

The entire purpose or aim of setting nationwide collegiate clinics is to the problems faced by the masses ignorant about their rights and remedies under the law. The aim is indeed a noble one but there are difficulties that are needed to be addressed. Vivekananda Law College, Puttur D. K. Legal Aid clinic is one successful beacon while there are many more colleges and universities where such beacons need to be lighted, many thousands whose legal dilemmas need to be effectively addressed.

Vivekananda Law College, Puttur Legal Aid and Services clinic is the body which inducts students to use their knowledge of law to provide free legal aid to those who are in need of it through various media. The object of Legal Aid is preventive, remedial, activist and reformative.

Our aim is to spread legal awareness among students and people at large. We endeavor to achieve this target by organizing legal literacy camps, seminars, workshops, legal counseling, public speaking and liasoning with Taluk Legal Services Authority and through various other communicable mediums.

### Aim and Objects:

The Legal Services Cell of Vivekananda Law College is basically aimed to provide free and competent legal service to the weaker sections of the society to ensure that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizen by reason of economic or other disabilities.

**Secondly,** creating legal awareness, legal aid and settlement of disputes amicably with the help of Puttur Taluk Legal Services Authority, Advocates and students of Vivekananda Law College who assist in this process and learn the art of conciliation.

**Thirdly,** Legal Awareness programs are taken up for empowerment of legal knowledge to all citizens in general and weaker sections of the society in particular.

Fourthly, various activities are taken up to reach vulnerable sections of the society by organizing Legal Aid Camps, conduct survey in identified villages to ascertain the problems that are faced by the poor and the needy as well as to help people to take the advantage of various social welfare laws that are implemented by the state, for example, oldage pension, widow pension, physically handicapped scholarships, helping in obtaining R.T.C. and Katha, scholarship benefits to the weaker sections of the society and to obtain financial benefits from recognized institutions, child rights, law relating to empowerment of women, SC/ST Atrocities Act, Motivating the children to go to schools, prohibition of child exploitation etc.

Vivekananda Law College organizes and renders free Legal Aid Services in its cell established in the campus throughout the year except on non-working days.

# **Inauguration of Moot Society and Legal Aid Committee**

On 18.09.2019 Moot Court society and Legal Aid Committee were inaugurated. Sri Manohar K.V Advocate and President of Puttur Bar association, Dr. B K Ravindra, Director of Legal studies, Smt. Akshatha A.P, Principal of Vivekananda Law College were present.





Sri Manohar KV gave the inaugural address to the students to become the model Vakil. Giving examples of the struggles Mahathma Gandhi faced during his initial days of practice, he suggested that in order to face the situations and overcome the hurdles, tomorrow we should prepare ourselves from now itself. Law students should study various citations to present cases before the court. Moot Courts are very necessary in the legal education and each and every student should participate in the competition, which helps them to have

practical information as to how the cases are being presented in the court. He concluded his speech saying that there is no retirement for the legal profession.

Dr. B.K Ravindra gave the presidential address to the students asking them to involve in the Moot Court and Mock trial proceedings. Moot Court is the replica of arguments in High Court. Mock trial is the replica of proceedings in the subordinate court. Interaction done by the students should be very effective. By involving the students in these activities students will gain courage, confidence and enhances their legal knowledge. He added that till the death knocks the door, advocate will always be an advocate which helps to lead a disciplined life. He also stated the importance of Legal Aid where the students are trained by the college and encouraged to participate in the paralegal activities and get the knowledge of various social welfare laws. A socio legal survey helps our students to understand the prevailing conditions and social problems of the concerned village and students can take an active role in helping poor and needy to avail the benefits of various beneficial schemes introduced by the governments.

## Legal Aid and Legal Awareness Camp

Vivekananda Law College, Puttur organized a One Day Legal Aid and Legal Awareness Camp at Beliyoorkatte, Government Pre-University College. In this program both Professors and Students of Law participated as Resource Persons. Smt.Sangeetha S.M, Assistant Professor of Law spoke on Career Opportunities in Law and how knowledge of law helps in reforming one's personality.

# National seminar on "New Education Policy-2019"

Seminar on New Education Policy 2019 was organized by Vivekananda Law College, Puttur on 23-11-2019 from 10.00 A.M to 4.00 P.M .17 resource persons and 300 delegates participated in the seminar. The main issues discussed in this seminar were New Educational Policy -2019. Honorable Justice Aravinda Kumar, Judge, Karnataka High Court, Bangalore inaugurated the seminar, Dr. NandanPrabhu, eminent educationist from Manipal University of Higher Education Manipal., Dr. O.V Nandimutt, Former Registrar and Professor NLSIU, Bangalore, Sri Ram Mohan Rao, Senior Advocate, Puttur, Dr. K.M Krishna Bhat, Secretary, Vivekananda Vidyavardhaka Sangha, Puttur, Sri Vijayanarayna K.M, Correspondent of Vivekananda Law College, Dr. B.K Ravindra Director of Legal Studies, Smt. Akshatha A.P Principal of Vivekananda Law College were present. Duringinaugural function the Legal Journal of the college "Legal Spectrum Volume –II" was released.



Honourable Justice Aravinda Kumar inaugurated the program and addressed the audience about the Education Policy. He said that parliament members, 97% are lawyers who are very important to frame the laws and said that education includes moral education. He briefed about the ancient time education about 5000 years ago, how Thakshasheela and Nalanda Universities functioned. He advised students to stand on their own feet and also to have love for the country. Mr. Aravinda Kumar mentioned about the Lord Macaulay appointed by British to break Indian education system. He said that teacher should be like a mother to a student.

Dr. NandanPrabhu, Guest of Honour addressed the audience about the educational and the constitutional values. He gave a good example of Advaitha philosophy where Shankaracharya was given a tool by his teacher and how it was implemented by him. Dr. NandanPrabhu said how the educational policy has to be implemented and said that education is a science of human possibility. He added that 2019 Education Policy is a modification of 1986 and continuation of 1992 policy. He spoke about the principles of law of gravitation, cognition, behavior, how education affects the life.

Dr. O.V.Nandimutt, Guest of Honour addressed the audience about the importance of education policies, how the financing of education is worked out. He stressed the problems faced by the students in higher education sector especially in case of materials, infrastructure, and said that research should be done which is useful to the society.

Dr. K.M. Krishna Bhat emphasized the need for evaluation of Education Policy 2019. Continuing his speech, spoke about the principles, values, vision, how continuous process of study should be done. Highlighting the future vision of new system of learning, he mentioned the priority given to understanding than mere memorization. Sri. M Ram Mohan Rao addressed the audience and said education is fundamental for achieving full human potential, developing an equitable and just society and promoting national development. Explaining the current policies of education system, he said that India will have the highest population of young people in the world over the next decade and our ability to provide high quality educational opportunities to them will determine future of our country.

# Free Legal Aid training for students

Vivekananda Law College organized Free Legal Aid programme for final year and fourth year students. Sri Suryanarayana N.K. Advocate, Civil Law Chamber, Smt. Akshatha A. P, Principal of Vivekananda Law College, Smt.Sangeetha S.M. Assistant Professor of Law; were present.



Advocate Suryanarayana N.K resource person of the programme addressed the students why Legal Aid is very important. Students of law should have the knowledge of law to deal with society. He mentioned about legal service Authorities Act 1987 and the provisions relating to Legal Aid. He spoke about Order33 CPC is an enabling provision which allows filing of a suit by an indigent person without paying the court fee at the initial stage.

He also gave information about Article 39A of the Indian Constitution for Free Legal aid. He also mentioned Article 14 and 21 of the Constitution saying that all citizens are equal and should have liberty to live their life. He mentioned that free Legal aid service is available to weaker section of the society, women, children, SC&ST and rural backward classes.

## Legal Awareness Program at Vivekananda Engineering and Management College

Vivekananda Law College organized Free Legal Aid programme for the students of Vivekananda Engineering and Management College on 21/11/2020 at Vivekananda Engineering and Management College campus.Dr. B. K. Ravindra, Director of Legal Studies, Vivekananda Law College, Puttur addressed the students and spoke aboutrecent changes brought to the Traffic Rules. Some of the basic traffic rules for two-wheeler riders in India are as follows:

- Helmets should be worn always while riding
- Indicators should be used by all riders
- Pillion riders cannot be more than one
- The rider should focus on the road all the time
- Usage of rearview mirrors is mandatory
- When pulling over, do so carefully

Indian roads are among the most notorious in the world as it claims over 1.5 lakh lives each year and most of it is due to people's lack of traffic sense. The central government previously failed to take the necessary steps however it has decided to crackdown on traffic offenses right now. This, they are doing by making the law and its subsequent punishment will be stricter. To take care of the same, the government tabled the Motor Vehicle (Amendment) Bill 2016 which was also been approved by the cabinet recently bringing the law into effect. This road safety bill has outlined punishments and penalties for all sorts of traffic violations. Hence Director advised the students and enlightened youth about the Motor Vehicle (Amendment) Bill 2016 with recent amendments.

## **Legal Aid Program**

Legal Aid is a mechanism to provide free Legal Aid to the people who are unable to afford legal representation and access to the court. Ignorance of law is no excuse. With this motto the students of Vivekananda law colleges visited schools and colleges to spread awareness about not only on legal rights but also about legal duties, we as citizens of India owe towards our nation a duty to uphold the law of the land. Legal aid committee has also set up a legal service clinic for legal awareness and providing legal assistance in the form of consultancy services.

On March 25, 2021 Legal Awareness Program was conducted at Vivekananda PU College. Total 62 students of PU were present the session. Dr. Rekha, Assistant Professor of law delivered lecture on Women and Law, where discussed about Uniform Civil Code, Provisions of IPC, Prevention of Domestic Violence and Criminal Laws. Smt. Subashini J Assistant Professor of law, being resource person gave a talk on Consumer Protection laws with Recent Amendments. While explaining the recent amendments, she said that on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the new Consumer Protection Act, 2019 came into force in India, replacing the previous enactment of 1986. The new Act overhauls the administration and settlement of consumer disputes in India. It provides for strict penalties, including jail terms for food adulteration and for misleading advertisements.


# **Legal Awareness Programme**

Sri Kaushik C Assistant Professor of law addressed the students with regard to career opportunities in different sectors of law. Kumari Shree Raksha, Assistant Professor of law gave a talk on Public Interest Litigation and said that Public Interest Litigation (PIL) has a vital role in the civil justice system in that it could achieve those objectives which could hardly be achieved through conventional private litigation. PIL offers a ladder to justice to disadvantaged sections of society, provides an avenue to enforce diffused or collective rights, and enables civil society to not only spread awareness about human rights but also allows them to participate in government decision making. PIL could also contribute to good governance by keeping the government accountable.



# **Special Talk on Public Interest Litigation**

A Special talk on PIL was conducted for Vivekananda Engineering and Law students at Vivekananda College of Management by Legal Aid Cell of Vivekananda Law College on 17/8/2021. The resource person of the programme was Dr. Shekhar Iyer, social activist and expert in Industrial and Labour Laws. He explained PIL as proceedings in which the public or the community at large has some pecuniary or legal interest, demonstrates an ability to foster human rights compliance and said that 'public' interests to be recognized and enforced through the judicial process, thereby revealing greater potential than private rights litigation in addressing the systemic nature of many human rights violations. This in turn has presented greater opportunities domestically to monitor each State's accountability to international human rights standards.

Honorable Justice Sri Rudolph Pereira addressing the gathering said that in the majority of cases, people who are feeling suicidal are dealing with conditions that will pass in time if only they can get the help that they need. In the meantime, there is much that friends and family members can do to help people who are depressed or contemplating suicide. Suicide occurs in all regions of the world. In fact, 77% of global suicides happen in low- and middle-income countries.

While the link between suicide and mental disorders (in particular, depression and alcohol use disorders) is well established, many suicides happen impulsively in moments of crisis. Further risk factors include experience of loss, loneliness, discrimination, a relationship break-up, financial problems, chronic pain and illness, violence, abuse, and conflict or other humanitarian emergencies. The strongest risk factor for suicide is a previous suicidal attempt. It takes a lot of courage to help someone who is suicidal. Witnessing a loved one dealing with thoughts about ending their own life can stir up many difficult emotions. As you're helping a suicidal person, don't forget to take care of yourself. Find someone that you trust...a friend, family member, clergyman, or counselor...to talk about your feelings and get support of your own said Dr. Anirudh, if a friend or family member is suicidal, the best way to help is by offering an empathetic, listening ear. Let your loved one know that they're not alone and that you care. Don't take responsibility, however, for healing your loved one. You can offer support, but you can't make a suicidal person get better. They have to make a personal commitment to recovery.

It takes a lot of courage to help someone who is suicidal. Witnessing a loved one dealing with thoughts about ending their own life can stir up many difficult emotions. As you're helping a suicidal person, don't forget to take care of yourself. Find someone that you trust a friend, family member or a counselor to talk about your feelings and get support of your own.

# Shankar Narayan Mayya v/s Shanthappa Gowda

Dispute- Settlement of illegal encroachment of road throughADR System

### Facts:

- 1. Agricultural property bearing the S No. 232/4P1 of Bandar village, Belthangady taluk of 2 acres of Sri Shankarnarayan Mayya's land was surrounded by the land bearing S No. 232/2P1 and 232/2P2 of 12.5 acres of patta and Kumki land of Shantappa Gowda.
- 2. S No. 232/4P1 and house of door bearing No. 130-III is having the road of 3 metres width is shown in the FMB sketch of Sri Shankarnarayana Mayya.
- 3. On 13/8/2016 Sri Shantappa Gowda in his kumki land, with mutual promise started an illegal red stone mining with the intention to make agricultural improvement in the future days.
- 4. He encroached the adjacent plot of land which was given by the government for the public road.
- 5. Due to quarrel among themselves, for the road and case was registered at police station, Dharmasthala. Due to lack of evidence, charge sheet was not filed by the police authorities.
- 6. Later, both contacted Mr. Suhas, who is a member of legal aid cell of our college and asked the legal aid due to old age and economical inconvenience.
- 7. Later, collecting the documents of said case, Mr. Suhas contacted the PDO, Tahashildar, AC, DC and sent a copy of the matter.
- 8. With the notice of Assistant Commissioner Puttur, Village Accountant and government surveyor took the initiation and visited the spot. Moreover, matter transferred to the Beltangady Tahashildar. The order passed under EDSLND(3B)CR 24/2021/B3/E-136983 and the copy was issued to the Shankarnarayana Mayya as an acknowledgement.
- 9. Matter was taken by the Belthangady Tahashildar and the notice was sent to both the parties in the matter of file number NCR124/20-21 to appear personally.
- 10.On 30.6.2021, both the parties were present. Final year student Mr. Suhas H who conveyed the facts to the Tahashildar.

11.By hearing both the parties, the Tahashildar passed an order to remove the illegal encroachment over the government land with the protection of police on 2/7/2021 at 11.00 a.m. Issue got resolved accordingly.
